What Is Loyalty?

"There is something wrong with your character if opportunity controls your loyalty"

Loyalty means standing by what you believe in without wavering, even when someone else may disagree with you. Loyalty is staying true to someone or something. It is a quality that involves plenty of trust, support, and commitment.

If we want to have successful relationships that last for a long time, we need to show loyalty. We can be loyal to our family, our friends, our school, our teams, and even our community.

You have to be careful about choosing what you commit yourself to, because if you are loyal, you will stand behind that commitment for a long time. Be sure that the person, belief, or group continues to be worthy of your loyalty.

Activity: False Loyalty
